

The Money Shot

Inspired by the outlandish designs of his late friend Tony Zemaitis, the Teyé Super-Coyote was conceived by Dutch boutique builder Teyé Winterp.

Winterp studied flamenco guitar in Spain, before moving to Texas and playing in singer-songwriter Joe Ely's band, and the Super-Coyote's bold aesthetics are rooted in the Andalusia region and Moorish culture. Its LP-type outline is lavished with ostentatious acid-engraved aluminium plates and the body and neck are mahogany with a maple cap and ebony fretboard. Pickups come in the shape of a pair of custom-wound Jason Lollar humbuckers and the proprietary electrics include the MOJO™ Analog Spectrum Modeller, a custom-made potentiometer that opens up a wide spectrum of rocking tones.
